

The Mountain View Regional Waste Management Commission is responsible for managing solid waste within Mountain View County. We operate the Olds, Water Valley, Sundre and MVRWMC Didsbury waste transfer stations.

Please take a few minutes to read our guidelines for waste disposal to make your use of our facilities as easy and efficient as possible.

Your visit to our sites can be made easier by organizing the materials in your load (e.g. separating metals, lumber and hazardous wastes from your regular garbage) before you arrive at our site.

Always check in with the site attendant as you arrive at the Transfer Station and dump only as directed by our staff.

### **Acceptance of Burn Barrel Ashes**

Burn barrel ashes are accepted for disposal at our transfer stations *only* if they are contained in sealed garbage bags or boxes. Any ash that is not bagged will be refused, regardless of how long it has been cool. We do *not* provide bags at our transfer stations.

### **Scrap Metal**

All of our transfer stations have a separate pile for recycling of scrap metal. Any items that are predominantly metal will be directed to the metal pile at the discretion of the scale attendant. Regular per kilogram tipping fees apply to scrap metal.

### **Propane Tanks**

Propane tanks are accepted at all transfer stations at a cost to the customer.

### **Burn Pit Regulations**

#### **CLOSED AS OF JULY1/07**

Olds, Water Valley, Sundre  
Burning was never permitted at the Landfill Transfer Station.

### **Branches**

Branches are chipped at our facilities and at a minimal cost to the customer.

### **Waste Oil**

Waste engine and hydraulic oil, oil filters and empty oil containers are accepted at our transfer stations at no charge if deposited in the designated areas. There is a 20 liter per customer limit, and customers must drain their containers in to the bulk oil storage. Waste oil, filters and plastic oil containers are recycled as part of the Alberta Used Oil Management Association's recycling program.

### **Tires**

Old tires that have been removed from rims are accepted at our transfer stations.

### **Freon Containing Appliances**

Refrigerators and freezers are subject to a freon removal surcharge per item. There is a designated area at each transfer station for disposal of freon containing appliances.

### **Household Hazardous Waste**

We have special sheds at all of our transfer stations to accept household chemical products. Our facilities are for household hazardous chemicals only. **Commercial, industrial or agricultural chemicals are not accepted at any of our sites. Residential Drop-offs - NO CHARGE**

The following household hazardous wastes are acceptable for disposal at our sites but **must be kept separated** from the regular waste stream:

- Aerosol spray cans
- Paint and solvents
- Cleaning Products
- Yard and garden chemicals
- Automotive Batteries
- Light ballasts and electronic capacitors

### **Other Regulated Wastes**

The following materials are **banned** from disposal at our sites:

- Soils
- Dead Animals
- Dead Animal Parts
- Biomedical Waste

**We reserve the right to refuse any materials. There is a \$20.00 charge for loads not properly secured.**

## **Recycling**

The Commission has set up bins for collection of recyclable material at the following locations in Mountain View County.

- Didsbury Recycle Depot
- Olds Transfer Station
- Sundre Recycle Depot
- Sundre Transfer Station
- Water Valley Transfer Station
- Cremona Recycle Depot
- Eagle Hill Coop
- MVRWMC Didsbury Transfer Station
- Olds: Olds Co-op and 49<sup>th</sup> Ave .

The following materials can be recycled at no charge at all recycle depots by all residents of Mountain View County:

- **Tin Cans** (rinsed and labels removed)
- **Glass** clear clean jars
- **Newspaper & Flyers** (no glossy magazines)
- **Corrugated Cardboard** (waffled cardboard) **Box Board** ie cereal boxes, pop cases, beer boxes, shoeboxes
- **Mixed Paper** glossy magazines,
- **Mixed Plastics** (Plastic film bags, toiletry containers, food containers, household containers).

Disposal of contaminated or non-recyclable material in the recycling bins is not permitted. Please help us keep recycling costs down by using these facilities responsibly.
