To All Residents within Mountain View County

The Mountain View Regional Waste Management Commission (MVRWMC) over the past year has made some major restructuring decisions. One of them is the outsourcing of our Fleet (Municipal Curb Side Pick Up). The MVRWMC has signed a contract with CanPak Environmental Inc. to transport waste from the Transfer Sites and Recycling Depots within the Mountain View County. This is effective October 1, 2015 for all Urban Municipalities, and for the County Residents this will be in effect January 1, 2016. The only difference will be a different name on the hauling trucks. The Commission has worked very hard to make this transition as easily as possible so there should be no disruptions in the picking up of your waste (black bin), compost (green bin) and recycling (blue bin). Your schedules will all be the same as they have been in the past.

To make things easier at our recycle depots the only items that need to be separated are the cardboard and boxboard items, all other material can go in the same bins. The materials that can all be deposited into the same bin will be as follows: mixed paper, newspaper, mixed plastics 1-7, cleaned tin cans and cleaned glass.

The Agricultural Plastics and Twine will be collected at the DIDSBURY LANDFILL ONLY.

CanPak will be notifying all commercial customers presently served by the MVRWMC with an update status on your continued service.

The Olds Transfer Site is closing as of October 1, 2015 for the purpose of our total restructuring of the Mountain View Regional Waste Management Commission. The cost of depositing your sorted residential waste at the Landfill now is \$100.00 per tonne versus the \$242.00 per tonne at any of the Transfer Sites.
